Nod for bills: SC reminds Guvs on **'ASAP' condition**

SC says 'as soon as possible' has constitutional implications, functionaries must keep it in mind

IN the plea filed by the Telangana government seeking directions to Governor Tamilisai Soundararajan to clear the 10 Bills passed by the State Legislature, the Supreme Court on Monday said that the Governor should keep in mind the phrase "as soon as possible" while ex-

pressing her intention to "assent to a Bill" or "withhold the same" under Article 200(1) of the Constitution before disposing of the plea.

After being informed that all the pending bills had been assented to by the Governor, a bench,

comprising Chief Justice of India DY Chandrachud and Justice PS Narasimha, stated in their order, "The communication dated April 23 from the Secretary to the Solicitor General (S-G) contains the status of the Bills pending. At this stage,

During the hearing, S-G Tushar Mehta informed the bench that there were no Bills pending as all had been assented to by the Governor.

They have urged that TAN-GEDCO should fill at least 1,000 posts in various categories in the department. A field staff, K Ganeshan (name changed) in Coimbatore told TNIE, "TANGEDCO will be filling up 200 technical assistant posts through the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission (TNPSC). However, no steps were taken to fill posts of field staff. As there are no adequate staff in the section office, we are facing work burden in the field work and are affected both physically and mentally."

SC quashes HC order shielding MP from arrest in Viveka murder case

THE Supreme Court on Monday set aside Telangana High Court order that had granted Kadapa MP Avinash Reddy interim protection from arrest and directed the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to conduct the investigation as per law in former minister YS Vivekananda Reddv murder case. The high court had directed the CBI to present its questionnaire in printed form and tape its interrogation of Avinash Reddy. Terming the high court order "premature", a bench of Chief Justice D Y Chandarchud and Justice PS Narasimha quashed the direction the HC had issued to the CBI.


